## 2-DAY ITINERARY

Choose your own family adventure  
in and around Canungra!



## DAY 1

### Early bird:

Rise and shine before dawn for an epic start to your Canungra adventure. Climb into the basket of a majestic hot air balloon and float quietly above rolling plains as the sun rises. See if you can spot a mob of kangaroos amongst the Scenic Rim beauty below. This is a bucket list experience the whole family will be talking about for years.

### Breaky buds:

On landing, it's time for a well-earned breakfast. Devour a delicious buffet at O'Reilly's Canungra Valley Vineyards' historic homestead, then pop across the paddock to meet the resident alpacas.

Feeling energetic? Take your fluffy new friends for a stroll. Just want to hang out? No prob-llamas. Snap some alpaca selfies and chill by beautiful Canungra Creek.

### Retreat:

O'Reilly's Rainforest Retreat, a 40-minute drive through Lamington National Park, is the ultimate eco-adventure playground. Check in to a self-contained villa, complete with a hot tub and an expansive deck and plan an adventure-filled afternoon.

### Flora:

Peer down at the rainforest canopy from the Rainforest Walk, a series of suspension bridges 16 metres above the ground. Next, zip along a 180-metre flying fox with epic views of Morans Creek below. Take an off-road Segway adventure, exploring ancient Gondwana rainforest, or buckle up for a guided 4WD tour. You can even visit a mystical glow worm grotto or sit and watch the sun set from a secret lookout cliff. Every option is awe-inspiring.

### Fauna:

Animal lovers, get up close and personal with Russ the friendly carpet snake, Maggie the cute-as-a-button magpie and other wild residents including possums, owls, crimson rosellas and gorgeous regent and satin bowerbirds. O'Reilly's epic 'Birds of Prey' show is a must-see, featuring kestrels, kites and magnificent wedgetail eagles. Kids can sign up for 'eco-ranger' activities during school holidays or learn how to make authentic billy tea and damper.





### Freedom:

While the children are well catered for, mums and dads can unwind with a glass of local sav blanc, a swim in the resort's inviting infinity pool and some well-deserved pampering at the exquisite Lost World Spa. It doesn't all have to be about the kids, does it?

### Dinner:

It's been a big day, so settle in for an early dinner, where you're likely to spot a brushtail possum or a sugar glider as you dine on a hearty menu offering plenty for little ones' palates.

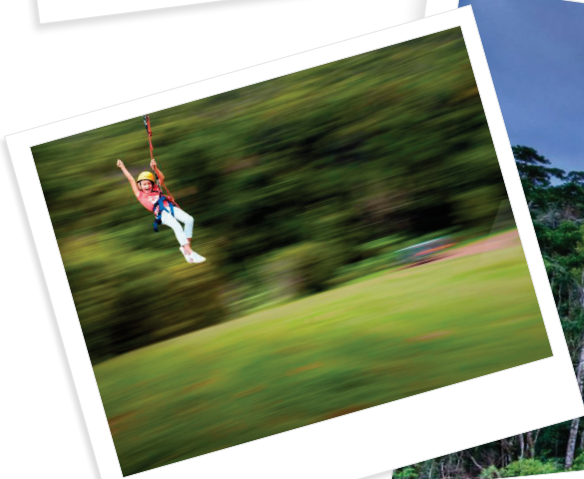
## DAY 2

### Fuel up:

Return to the dining room for a leisurely buffet breakfast while watching bowerbirds take their morning bath. Order a second coffee and study the trail guides to map out your next mountain adventure.

### Trek:

There are more than 320 kilometres of walking tracks winding through the mountains and valleys of Lamington National Park. We recommend starting from O'Reilly's and descending through sub-tropical rainforest to the top of the magnificent Morans Falls. From there, strong legs will want to continue on to Moonlight Crag, where a three-tier wooden deck offers spectacular views of the stunning McPherson ranges.



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## Pub lunch:

You'll be hungry after all that hiking, so grab a table at the landmark Canungra Hotel for a classic Aussie pub lunch. Choose from favourites such as parmies, steaks, burgers and gourmet wood-fired pizzas, all washed down with a schooner or two of local lager. Kids will love the games room and on-site jumping castle.

## Explore:

The village of Canungra is an adventure in itself. Explore an eclectic mix of shops and galleries, sample local honey and macadamia nuts at the Visitor Information Centre and check out DJ Smith Park, home to a huge kids' playground and fascinating stone cenotaph honouring the 135 men and women of the district who enlisted for the Great War.

## Keep going:

From Canungra, you're within easy reach of so many more epic Scenic Rim adventures. Which one will you choose next?
