

# Black Spot - Road safety upgrade works

November 2022

## Beechmont Road, Witheren

As part of Council's ongoing commitment to delivering an accessible and serviced region, Council will be undertaking road safety upgrade works at Beechmont Road, Witheren.

Works include pavement sealing, installation of audio tactile line marking, guide posts and curve alignment markers.

### WHEN WILL IT HAPPEN?

Works are scheduled to commence in late November 2022 and are expected to take 6 weeks to complete, weather and construction conditions permitting. Works will generally occur between 6.30am to 6.00pm Monday to Saturday.

### WHERE WILL IT HAPPEN?

Works will take place in several sections along Beechmont Road between Rhoades Road and Farm Grove Road.

### WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

Temporary traffic management and partial closures may be required and detours will be sign posted. Access will be maintained to all properties. Construction plant will be active in the area during project construction, and there will be noise and vibration at the sites. Every effort has been made to keep disruption to a minimum to reduce the impact on the travelling public.

Your patience and understanding are appreciated as Council delivers this improvement to the road network.
