

Black Spot - Road safety upgrade works

November 2022

Munbilla Road, Milora

As part of Council's ongoing commitment to delivering an accessible and serviced region, Council will be undertaking road safety upgrade works at Munbilla Road, Milora.

Works include the pavement widening, improved horizontal and vertical alignment, installation of guardrail, line marking and roadside drainage.

WHEN WILL IT HAPPEN?

Works are scheduled during January 2023 to May 2023, weather and construction conditions permitting. Works will generally be carried out between 6.30am to 6.00pm Monday to Saturday.

WHERE WILL IT HAPPEN?

Works will take place along the Munbilla Road and Ellis and Jackson Road intersection.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

Temporary traffic management and partial closures may be required and detours will be sign posted. Access will be maintained to all properties. Construction plant will be active in the area during project construction, and there will be noise and vibration at the sites. Every effort has been made to keep disruption to a minimum to reduce the impact on the travelling public.

Your patience and understanding are appreciated as Council delivers this improvement to the road network.
