Road Restoration Works

As part of Council's commitment to provide ongoing investment in its road network and to deliver an accessible and serviced region, Council will be undertaking restoration works on various sections of sealed and unsealed roads across our region.

Council has secured jointly-funded Commonwealth-State Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements (DRFA) to improve an approximate 4.5 km section of Teviotville Road, Kalbar. The total project cost of \$3,124,453.00 is jointly funded by Council and DRFA funding program.

When will it happen?

Works are scheduled to commence late April 2023 and are expected to take four (4) months to complete, weather and conditions permitting. Works will generally occur between 6:00am and 6:00pm, Monday to Saturday.

Where will it happen?

Works will occur on Teviotville Road for approximately 4.5 kilometres. The restoration works will commence from the Haag Road and Hoya Road intersection and travel in a westerly direction to the intersection of Old Kalbar Road and Teviotville Road. What can I expect?

Residents will experience road closures, reduced speed limits and traffic detours around the restoration works for each section, allowing the construction crews to undertake their work, safely and efficiently.

Property access will be maintained throughout the works to ensure minimal delays are experienced to local residents and businesses.

Every attempt has been made to minimise disruptions to the travelling public, however, given the nature of planned construction activities, some sections of the work area will be closed during work hours to allow our crews to undertake these works safely. Advanced communication of the closure dates will be made (as a minimum) available on site via Variable Message Boards and Council's website outlining these planned closure details.

Construction plant and personnel will be active in these areas during construction working hours. Roadwork signage and traffic controllers will be in place to guide motorists and pedestrians safely through and/or around the construction site.

Council acknowledges there will be inconvenience to local residents, business owners, pedestrians and motorists while these works are being undertaken. Your patience and understanding is appreciated.
