Stormwater network upgrades

Works to improve the underground stormwater network on Brisbane and Eaglesfield Streets are continuing and are expected to completed early 2025.

These works will address the longstanding issue with flooding and the road substructure, delivering major drainage improvements which are vital to businesses in the Beaudesert town centre and the safety of the community during major rain events. *This project is jointly funded by the Australian Government's Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program in association with Scenic Rim Regional Council.* Please read this notification of works in conjunction with the separate Notification of Works for Short Street Drainage.

When will it happen?

Works are underway and are will generally occur between 6:00 am and 6:00 pm, Monday to Saturday, with the exception of proposed night works to minimise disruptions during the day and impact to the public (weather and construction conditions permitting).

Where will it happen?

Works will continue on the Eaglesfield Street and Brisbane Street intersection and the western side of Brisbane Street (Davidson Park), up to the Selwyn Street Intersection. Please refer to the map to view the location of these works and street specific information on the next page for further details.

What can I expect?

Access to Eaglesfield Street from Brisbane Street has been temporarily closed to undertake water main replacements, build sewage protection and install new stormwater infrastructure.

Access will be reinstated at this intersection in the coming weeks however further stormwater works will continue along Eaglesfield Street, under a partial road closure, minimising traffic and pedestrian movements.

Detour routes and alternative access points will be made available and community are encouraged to follow posted detour signs and to plan travel routes accordingly.

Residents and business owners will experience temporary road closures and traffic detours for the duration of this stage as well as the restriction of pedestrian movements. Variable Message Boards (VMS) are now in place throughout the area to help you navigate and stay informed during the ongoing construction works.

Heavy vehicles are encouraged to use the bypass as the alternative route.



Residents and businesses can expect construction noise, vibration and temporary water supply interruptions and will receive notifications advising of the impacts once dates and time can be confirmed with the contractor and / or Urban Utilities, dependent on the works being undertaken.

On the western side of Brisbane Street, the contractor is working to install and complete kerb works, the footpath and landscaping. This section is currently closed to pedestrians, and is planned to re-open in October, which will allow the public to utilise this side of the road and access the new parklands area. Motorists are advised to follow the lane markers until the completion of these works.

Council acknowledges there will be inconvenience to local residents, business owners, pedestrians and motorists while these works are being undertaken. Your patience and understanding is appreciated.
